

The Hidden Art of the late Desmond Jones



Desmond Jones was a professional artist, who studied at Twickenham Art School, now Richmond upon Thames College (RuTC), during World War II. He worked as a graphic designer and photographer, for a living, but painted incredible, vibrant work at home for the love of his art. He never exhibited his work during his life time and it remained hidden until after his death in 2013. In 2016 one of the Desmond Jones "Dancer" works was presented to RuTC with a plaque about his connection to the college. Some of his other work was seen and admired at this event and his daughter, Elaine, decided his art deserved some recognition and could benefit some charities at the same time, so she arranged this extraordinary auction!
